

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

The Village observes 10 legal holidays and two additional holidays. On these holidays, Village offices are closed and services are usually suspended for the day. Unless informed of a schedule change, residents can expect that there is no trash and recycling collection and no street cleaning on these days. Typically, all services resume the following business day.

Holiday Collection Schedule

If you have DPW collection service, all garbage, recyclables and bulk collection will be one day following the holiday. For instance, if your normal collection day is Monday and the holiday falls on a Monday, then your trash will be picked up on Tuesday; Tuesday's trash day will then be picked up on Wednesday; Wednesday's trash will be picked up on Thursday, and so on.

Below is a list of observed holidays for 2009.

- January 1 – New Year's Day
- January 21 – Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
- February 12 – Lincoln's Birthday
- February 18 – President's Day
- May 26 – Memorial Day
- July 4 – Independence Day
- September 1 – Labor Day
- October 13 – Columbus Day
- November 4 – Election Day
- November 11 – Veterans Day
- November 27 – Thanksgiving Day
- December 25 – Christmas Day

When a holiday falls on Saturday, the holiday is observed on the Friday before. When a holiday falls on a Sunday, the holiday is observed on the following Monday.
