I'm writing to share some exciting news about pending capital projects in the Village.

Additional progress was made regarding the conversion of all of the Village streetlights to LED fixtures. Those of you familiar with LED lighting know that these units produce a crisper, brighter light than traditional fixtures and well-lit streets are safer streets. The added bonus, of course, is that they use significantly less energy, meaning lower utility bills.


It's my pleasure to announce that the West Haverstraw Village Board has approved some major infrastructure projects for Jones Drive. The first step in the project is to upgrade your underground utilities. Once the winter is behind us, Orange and Rockland will be approved to upgrade the underground gas main on the street. When the gas main replacement is complete, the Village will begin a drainage project to install catch basins. We have already approved a contractor and have the financing in place for this project.

However, what I am most excited to announce is, after the drainage and utilities upgrades are completed, your streets will be paved. This excites me most because you will be able to physically see this improvement!

Coordinating efforts with our utility companies takes additional time, but the benefit is a complete project from the ground up. As I have stated, and you may have heard, it is my goal to make the necessary improvements to ensure the Village's aging infrastructure is sound.
